Feeding requirements

Changing Diets Abrupt changes in your pet's diet may cause intestinal irritation and/or soft stools. Pets First recommends a gradual change from the old diet to the new Earth Options by Pets First diet. This can easily be accomplished without pet discomfort over a two to five day period. In rare instances up to ten days may be required.
